



ADDENDUM TO BY-LAW 52 – REPLACEMENT PLAYERS

52.2 Representative Players

Should any player eligible for a CNW match be required for International, Interstate, Intrastate and/or Greater Northern Raiders duties, that requirement shall take precedence and the club shall be entitled to replace the player without the consent of the opposition player in accordance with the items below:

- (a) Prior to the commencement of a CNW match, a representative player who is also selected to play in a CNW match, may be replaced by any player eligible to play for the club.

The replacement player will assume the role of the replaced player in every respect (with the exception of underage bowling limits which are applicable to each individual based on their age), including the right to:

- i. Bat (where the replaced player has not already been dismissed, or immediately complete an innings that a replaced player has commenced);
- ii. Bowl;
- iii. Wicket Keep.

- (b) The replacement player's name shall be noted on the team sheet next to the replaced player prior to the toss, notwithstanding By-Law 52.2 (d) below. Should the replaced player return prior to the close of the match; they may resume their place in every respect, except:

- i. The right to bat in an innings in which his replacement has already been dismissed;
- ii. In a limited overs match the right to bowl overs in the allocated quota already completed by the replacement player.

- (c) A player taking part in a CNW match that has already commenced before being called on for representative duties can be replaced. In this instance the club is to provide notice of the replacement player(s) to the Umpires Advisor and opposition Captain by 5.00 pm on the Friday prior to match day.

- (d) If a player returning to their club from representative duties is not listed as a replacement player on the team sheet, the player may only play in a match if the club provides notice of the replacement player(s) to the Umpires Advisor and opposition Captain by 5.00 pm on the Friday prior to match day.

- (e) Any replacement players added after the commencement of a match are to be added to the team sheets provided to the match umpires and opposition Captain and entered in MyCricket.

- (f) The use of replacement players only covers instances where players are replaced in the selected teams due to representative duties. For all other players, By-Law 53 pertaining to "substitute" players applies.

52.3 Replacement of Non-Representative Players

This By-Law only applies to the following situations:

- i. Where a player is selected in a representative team (as per 52.2 above) and subsequent changes are required to the nominated 2nd Grade team.
- ii. Where 1st Grade and 2nd Grade are playing different match formats, and changes are required to the nominated 2nd Grade team due to 1st Grade team selections.

- (a) Should a player in 2nd Grade be unable to participate in either day of a Two-Day match for either of the reasons listed in 52.3 (i) and (ii) above, they shall be entitled to a replacement player for that day.

The replacement player will assume the role of the replaced player in every respect (with the exception of underage bowling limits which are applicable to each individual based on their age), including the right to:

- iv. Bat (where the replaced player has not already been dismissed, or immediately complete an innings that a replaced player has commenced);
- v. Bowl;
- vi. Wicket Keep.

- (b) The replacement player's name must be placed on the team sheet next to the replaced player prior to the toss, and indicate which player is participating in Day 1 and Day 2 respectively.
- (c) A player taking part in a CNW match that has already commenced before can be replaced (subject to satisfying the conditions of 52.3 (i) and (ii) above). In this instance the club is to provide notice of the replacement player(s) to the Umpires Advisor and opposition Captain by 5.00 pm on the Friday prior to match day.
- (d) If a player is not listed as a replacement player on the team sheet, the player may only play in a CNW if the club provides notice of the replacement player(s) to the Umpires Advisor and opposition Captain by 5.00 pm on the Friday prior to match day.
- (e) Any replacement players added after the commencement of a match are to be added to the team sheets provided to the match umpires and opposition Captain and entered in MyCricket.
- (f) The use of replacement players only covers instances where players are replaced in the selected teams due to 52.3 (i) and (ii) above. For all other players, By-Law 53 pertaining to "substitute" players applies.
