#### BY-LAW ERROR- T20 OVER RATES/TIMEFRAMES

There has been an error identified in the published and online versions of the Senior Rules Handbook.

Following the removal of the 5 overs of play from each end rule, timeframes for completion of innings have been extended from 1 hour and 10 minutes (70 minutes) to **1 hour and 15 minutes (75 minutes) for Senior T20 matches.**
