### CNW Media Launch

CNW have planned a media launch on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> October, to occur at the Club Development Expo at 7.25pm. Each club is asked to send **one female senior and junior, and one male senior and junior player**, to appear in full one day kit for photos for promotional purposes. The Advocate will be in attendance on the night, so it is also asked that clubs make their **1<sup>st</sup> grade Captain and Coach** available for photos and questions. Having 1<sup>st</sup> grade captains and coaches there will also provide CNW an opportunity to discuss the changes to By-laws and playing conditions for the 2019/20 season.

Laptops should be ready for pick up at the Club Development Expo.

### Overage Junior Player Process

CNW has recently developed a process for application of overage junior players that clubs can now use. Clubs are to fill out the below Survey Monkey with the relevant information about the player, as well as reasoning for application. CNW will then review these applications and provide clubs with feedback.

Major reasoning for overage players is the players skills and ability and the benefit to their development as cricketers that an extra year in a lower age group would provide, but also includes clubs ensuring they can provide appropriate opportunities for kids to play cricket, having the player numbers to fill sides, and players being close to the age cut-off dates.

Applications will remain open throughout the season, so clubs can apply mid-season if they believe is necessary.

### MyCricket Online Registration Process

In preparation for the commencement of the season, please be reminded that as part of the Online Registration changes for season 2019/20, all roles will need to have an active registration in order for a player to be selected. While all juniors are required to complete their registration online, senior players can have their registration added to by a club administrator.

### U-14 Girls Development League and Gala Day

The **Under-14 Girls** is a newly introduced competition, with the format designed for players who are relatively new to the game and are to looking to experience organised club cricket for the first time. Games will be played on one Sunday and two Wednesday evenings, under similar playing conditions to the Female 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade competition, played with a modified ball with focus on participation and enjoyment of the game.

Further details on the rules and playing conditions will be released in the Junior Rule Handbook prior to the junior season commencing on November 10<sup>th</sup>.

The season will commence with a Gala Day at Latrobe Rec 2 on **Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> December**, which will coincide with the Female 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Gala Day and Greater Northern Women's team T20, making for a great day of female cricket and allowing for increased support of the GN Raiders Female team.
