## Administration/Competition Notices

### Electronic Scoring Updates

A reminder for clubs to please contact Josh Marshall to organise a time for laptop drop off at the Hobart Hurricanes Community Office in Devonport in preparation for the upcoming season. Total Cricket Scorer and the Duck Worth Lewis systems on these laptops require updates prior to Round 1 so it is important clubs do this. This is only relevant to First Grade Men's scoring Device.

### CNW Senior Competition

The CNW Senior draft competition fixtures for the Men's First Grade, Men's and Women's Greater Northern Cups, Women's First Grade, Men's Second Grade and the Social League are now live on MyCricket and the CNW website.

Clubs are asked to request any match alterations to Josh Marshall, along with the reasoning for these changes by COB Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> September. An example of these changes could be changing Women's First Grade fixtures to Friday night feature matches or Senior Men's fixtures starting earlier to accommodate for potential club functions.

Please note: There have been some alterations to the initial draft fixtures sent to clubs following club feedback and due to ground availability, as well as alterations to initial Greater Northern Cup fixtures after further collaboration with Cricket North, and that is reflective of the fixtures posted to MyCricket.

### Club Contacts

All clubs are asked to complete the Club Affiliation process as outlined in more detail further in this document. This includes the Club Contacts spreadsheet sent out with the previous edition of the CNW Bulletin

The Club Contact spreadsheets will be used to update mailing lists and rules handbooks for the 2019/20 season, and details will also be shared with relevant Cricket Tasmania staff members. Coach contact details will also be shared with local media outlets.

### Junior Boys Gala Day

CNW will be introducing a Boys Pre-Season Gala Day this year, set to be held on Sunday 27<sup>th</sup> October. This will give clubs the opportunity to assess if their plans of nominations of junior teams are accurate as well as provide junior players a chance to get back into the swing of playing cricket.

### Female Development Gala Day

Cricket Tasmania is again organising a pre-season Gala day for prospective CNW Female players. The event will be staged on Sunday October 27 at Maidstone Park and will provide each team with the opportunity to participate in multiple games without the pressure of playing for competition points.

### Clearances & Transfers

Clubs should be ensuring they are being active in seeking clearances for their new recruits, as well as clearing those players leaving your club.

The process for clearances and transfers remains the same as last year. Please contact Josh Marshall if you have any questions about this process, particularly if you are unsure as to whether to apply for a transfer or clearance for a specific player.

### Sporting Schools Receives Additional Funding!

There will be a higher demand on coaching providers for the Sport Aus Sporting Schools Program. This is due to the Australian Government wanting to support more children to meet the daily physical activity guidelines of at least 60 minutes of moderate-vigorous physical activity. This will see an increase in the number of schools that are awarded grants each term by approximately 30%.
