**Electronic Scoring Updates**

Thanks to Wynyard and Ulverstone Cricket Clubs for prompt laptop drop off, and a reminder for other clubs to please contact Josh Marshall to organise a time for laptop drop off. Total Cricket Scorer and the Duck Worth Lewis systems on these laptops require updates prior to Round 1 so it is important clubs do this. Laptops should be ready for pick up at the Club Development Expo.

**CNW First Grade Fixture Alterations**

Due to the Men’s Big Bash League game in Launceston on the 19<sup>th</sup> of January we have decided to reschedule the CNW First Grade T20 Finals Day. This will now be played the Sunday prior on the **12<sup>th</sup> of January**, with the Greater Northern Cup Semis and Final also rescheduled (originally Sunday Jan 12<sup>th</sup> and Sunday Jan 26<sup>th</sup>, **now Monday Jan 27<sup>th</sup>, and Sunday Feb 2<sup>nd</sup>**).

As a result, we have had to reschedule the final T20 round previously scheduled for Thursday the 16<sup>th</sup> of January to **Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> December**. Please outline any issues you may see with these changes and communicate these with Josh Marshall by **1<sup>st</sup> October**.

**CNW Senior Fixtures**

The CNW Senior draft competition fixtures for the Men’s First Grade, Men’s and Women’s Greater Northern Cups, Women’s First Grade, Men’s Second Grade and the Social League are now live on MyCricket and the CNW website.

Please note: These fixtures are still subject to minor changes as we work through issues with ground availabilities, club feedback and working with Cricket North in relation to Greater Northern Cups.

**CNW Junior Programs 2019/20**

CNW will be offering the following junior programs for the 2019/20 season: **Under-13 Boys, Under-15 Boys, Under-17 Boys, Under-17 Girls and Under-14 Girls**.

Rules and playing conditions will remain relatively the same for **Under-13, Under-15 and Under-17 Boys** competitions, with changes highlighted in the Junior Rules Handbook, set to released soon.

The **Under-14 Girls** is a newly introduced competition, with the format designed for players who are relatively new to the game and are to looking to experience organised club cricket for the first time. Games will be played on a Wednesday evening, under similar playing conditions to the Female 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade competition, played with a modified ball with focus on participation and enjoyment of the game.

The **Under-17 Girls** rules have also undergone some changes to create more of a pathway to the Senior Female competitions. These changes will be highlighted in the Junior Rules Handbook.

Included in this Bulletin is a first draft of a date/time playing matrix for the junior competitions.

**CNW Media Launch**

CNW have planned a media launch on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> October, to occur at the Club Development Expo at 7.25pm. Each club is asked to send **one female senior and junior, and one male senior and junior player**, to appear in full one day kit for photos for promotional purposes.

A timeline for this media launch will be developed in the coming days and will be communicated in next week’s bulletin.

**Cricket Tasmania Representative Recognition Program**

This year CT is introducing the Representative Recognition Program for all Tasmanian Cricket Clubs. The program has been implemented to recognise and reward the efforts of clubs in developing players to represent Tasmanian underage teams and the Tasmanian Tigers. The full details of the program including eligibility of players and funding is included in the attached PDF.

The first team to be announced since the program has come into effect is the Tasmanian Male Under 17’s team to compete at the Cricket Australia National Male Under 17 Championships in Mackay from the 30<sup>th</sup> September to 10<sup>th</sup> October. Clubs with players selected in the Under 17’s team will shortly receive a letter from CT advising them of the eligibility of the players in accordance with the program and the process for payment.
