MYCRICKET LIVE SCORE APPLICATION

If you are currently having any issues with your MyCricket Live Score application during play or otherwise, please ensure you have updated the application. Some issues are occurring due to an old version of the app being used.

Additionally, please ensure you lean on the MyCricket Live Score guide that has previously been provided – this will get you out of the stickiest situations! A cheat sheet is also attached.

TIP: Don't hesitate in stopping the game if you need to amend a scoring issue. Please work closely with your umpires to ensure the game is scored correctly, and if that means stopping for a few minutes, please do so.
