The up skill will be held during the WBBL match on Sunday 3 November, in the West Park Oval Function centre.

PRE-SEASON JUNIOR AND FEMALE GALA DAY

Cricket North West will this Sunday the 27th of October host pre-season junior gala days for the U-13 and U-15 Boys, as well for the Senior female competition.

These gala days will be an excellent way to provide junior and female players a chance to get back into the swing of cricket and allow clubs to assess if their current plans of nominations of junior teams are accurate. Please see the information below outlining the process for the day, as well as the full fixture list.

U-13 and U-15 Boys

- Clubs to supply umpires and scorers, with the 'home' team as per MyCricket to be the one that live scores
- Coaches to ensure games get underway on time

- Clubs to supply and use regular roster match balls (outlined later in the bulletin) but clubs are also permitted to use last season's left-over red junior balls if they desire, the same ball can be used for both games if clubs wish
- Canteens will be open at host grounds and we encourage clubs to support these
- Host clubs will be providing equipment for ground set-up but please assist these clubs in this process
 - Full rules for U-13 and U-15 T20s are attached

Female

- Clubs to supply scorers, with the 'home' team as per MyCricket to be the one that live scores
- Clubs are to supply and use regular roster match balls, the same ball can be used for both games if clubs wish
- CT Staff will provide equipment for ground set-up and assist clubs in this process

JUNIOR CRICKET BALLS

Cricket North West will this season introduce the requirement that all Junior matches are to be played with white balls.

The match balls for each age group are outlined below.

Age Group	Ball Type	Approved Balls
U-13s	White 142-gram, 2 piece	Tuf-Pitch, Special Test, Red King, Colt, Crown or Kooka Practice
U-15s	White 156-gram, 2 piece	Tuf-Pitch, Special Test, Red King or Colt
U-17s	White 156-gram, 4 piece	Regulation, Regulation Reject, Club Match or Senator

BY-LAW ERROR IN SENIOR RULES HANDBOOK

There was an error in the recently published Senior Rules Handbook. Clause 125, which refers to time saving measure in 1st Grade and 2nd Grade T20 Matches is incorrect. The five overs of play from each end rule has been scrapped for the 2019/20 season. The online version of the Senior Rules Handbook will be changed to reflect this.
