CRICKET NORTH WEST JUNIOR CRICKET UP SKILL

Thank you to Ulverstone, Sheffield and Burnie for attending the CNW Junior Cricket Up Skill over the weekend.

All those who participated generated some great discussion around what purpose our junior formats serve, with an emphasis on fun learning experiences, catering for each ability level.

This will provide the best opportunity for our junior cricketers to stay with cricket for life.

Please see attached the Junior Cricket Up Skill presentation that was used on Sunday. All Junior Development Officers are encouraged to use this to up skill any coaches necessary.

JUNIOR 'HOME' TEAM RESPONSIBILITIES AND TIMELINES

It is the responsibility of the 'home' team for all junior matches to ensure matches are scored using the MyCricket Live Score app

and that a pre-match ground inspection takes place, including the completion of the JLT Game Day Checklist prior to the game commencing.

The checklist is available as a mobile app, search for "Cricket Match Day"

Pictured below is a guide and timeline on how 'home' teams volunteers can approach match days.

Time prior to match commencing	Action
45 minutes- 1 hour	Ground Inspection <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Check conditions are safe and <u>take action</u> to address any potential risks• Complete JLT Game Day Checklist ("Cricket Match Day app")
45 minutes- 1 hour	Unlock toilets and facilities
30 minutes- 45 minutes	Ground Set-up <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Measure and mark boundaries with cones• Measure and use tape to mark pitch (Under 13s only)• Stumps• Table and chairs for scorers
15 minutes- 20 minutes	Set-up scoreboard, additional shade shelters/marquees, chairs
15 minutes- 20 minutes	Collect team sheet and set-up MyCricket Live Score device

JUNIOR BOYS ROSTERS

The Bendigo Bank Cricket North West Junior competition fixtures for the boys Under-13, Under-15 and Under-17 are complete and are now live on MyCricket and the CNW website.

The Under-17 T20 roster will be developed and released soon.

A majority of Under-15 matches have been scheduled on synthetic venues, excluding Sheffield as they do not have an Under-17s team, but we encourage clubs to where possible move these matches onto turf.

Please note: These rosters are still subject to slight changes as venues are confirmed. All updates will be made on MyCricket so we encourage all parents/supporters/helpers for junior teams to download the MyCricket app to view full and up-to-date rosters.
